Course Fee & Facilities

Both CommTECH Insight & Highlight 2015 are open for 50 overseas students, academics, and professionals with any academic background. No specific technical/practical skills required to join the program. Participants need to specify the Sub-Course he/she would like to select when applying for the Insight program. With various unforgettable activities offered in 9 days, the fee to join this program is very affordable, i.e USD 1,600,- per participant for each program (CommTECH Insight or CommTECH Highlight). The fee will cover airport pick-up & drop-off, accommodation and all scheduled meals for 10 days, local transport, course materials, workshop tools & materials such as cotton fabrics, *canting*, wax & dye for batik production practice, T-shirt & backpack. Please note that return flight & health insurance are not part of the fee. Participant must arrange their own health insurance prior to the departure, if needed.

Application & Scholarships

- The registration will be opened:
 - From 1st October 2014 to 5th January 2015 for CommTECH Insight 2015
 - From 1st April to 5th July 2015 for CommTECH Highlight 2015

- We provide three types of **SCHOLARSHIPS*** for **each program** as follows:
 - **Ten (10) full scholarships** participants don't pay the course fee at all
 - **Ten (10) 50% scholarships** participants just pay \$800
 - **Five (5) partial scholarships** participants just pay \$1,000
- Successful participants with or without scholarship will be notified by email maximum one month after the application submission
- Participants who have to pay full or partial course fee are requested to pay the fee no later than the final date of the registration
- Acceptance letter or invitation letter will be provided for visa arrangement
