Announcement for students of member universities in Indonesia, the Philippines, Singapore, Thailand and Vietnam

OBJECTIVE

To provide a joint study trip program for students from Tokyo Tech- AYSEAS member universities in Japan, Indonesia, the Philippines, Singapore, Thailand and Vietnam.

Participants can learn much from the dynamism of fast-growing Asia in industry, education and governance through discussion and communication with students from different backgrounds. Tokyo Tech-AYSEAS 2015 is the successor to the Japan-Asia Young Scientist and Engineer Study Visit (JAYSES) program, which began in 2007.

PROGRAM

11-day study visit to Indonesia (Jakarta and Yogyakarta) (September 6 – 16, 2015)

- (1) **Visit**: Indonesian/Japanese companies, government organizations, educational facilities, and research institutes, etc.
- (2) **Discussion**: The participants will separate into several groups according to chosen topics to exchange opinions.
- (3) **Presentation**: Each group will give a presentation after the discussion.

TOPICS for DISCUSSION

Main theme: "From Asia to the World"

The topics for Tokyo Tech-AYSEAS 2015 will be given on the first day of the program.

Example topics of Tokyo Tech-AYSEAS 2014 held in Vietnam:

Motorization and traffic jams

Development of energy resources and protection of environment

Education and industrial management

Innovation and regional/global competition

Cultural difference and understanding on different culture

• HOW TO APPLY?

- (2) The Tokyo Tech-AYSEAS Administration Office will forward the application forms to the students' home universities for selection.
- (3) The member universities nominate the successful applicants with priority order and send the results to the Tokyo Tech-AYSEAS Administration Office.
- (4) After receiving nominations from member universities, the Tokyo Tech-AYSEAS Administration Office will send the acceptance notices to each successful candidate asking about his/her intention to join the program.
- (5) The successful candidates should reply to the Tokyo Tech-AYSEAS Administration Office within one week of receiving the acceptance notice.

REQUIREMENTS

- (1) Applicants should have the proper ability to communicate in written and spoken English.
- (2) Students need to participate in all program activities held in both Jakarta and Yogyakarta. Therefore, students must be able to travel to both cities.

EXPENSES

Participating students are responsible for the cost of their:

- 1) Airfare (Your home → Jakarta → Yogyakarta → Your home)
- 2) Accommodation
- 3) Travel insurance
- 4) Meals during the program
