# Call for abstracts/papers

Authors are invited to submit abstract (type a: short (within one page and follow with full paper) and type b: long abstracts only (within two pages)) to a scientific committee of the conference who will evaluate the submitted short and long abstracts. The notification of acceptance will be dispatched after the decision making from the scientific committee. The authors of accepted short abstract are then requested to send full papers. Only accepted full papers (for type a) and long abstracts (type b) will be published in the proceedings.

# **Technical Trainings**

Two technical trainings on (a)GCM downscaling and bias correction techniques with big data platform and (b)Water Security/ SDG6 Assessment are prepared half day each in the third day of the conference.

The official language of the conference will be English. All abstracts, papers should be submitted in English.
